Deciding on a storage system

- Decision criteria were
 - Price (might once have stopped here...)
 - Performance
 - Function
- Now
 - Compliance – failures might even be a veto
 - Storage team probably have no choice

Some compliance examples

- **Software and hardware**

- Special userids
- Role-based access
- Named users
- Robust authentication:
 - password rules and lifetime
 - SAF or Active Directory or ...
- Encryption algorithms
- RACF operations limitation

- **Hardware**

- Remote access
- Splash screen content
- Microcode fallback
- Audit CE actions
- Logging any admin action
- Media destruction

- **Standards compliance**
